Investment style

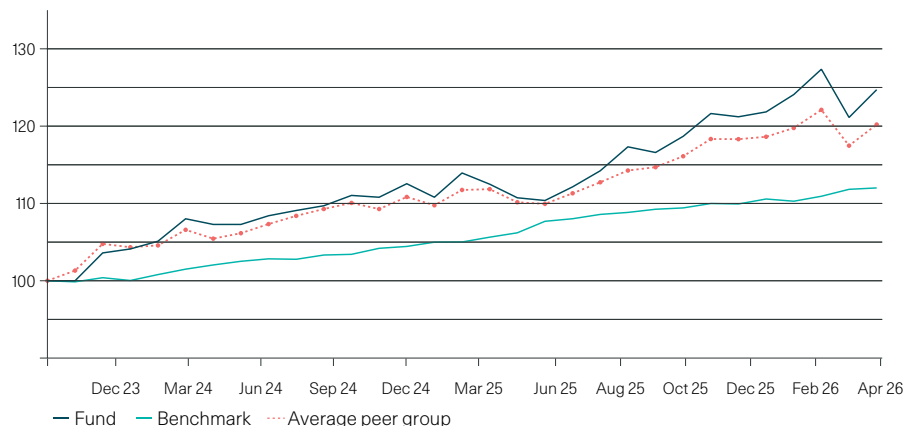

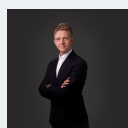

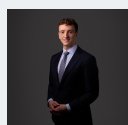
