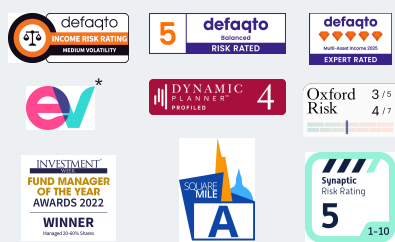
Investment style

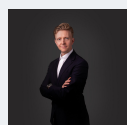

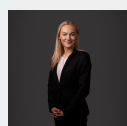

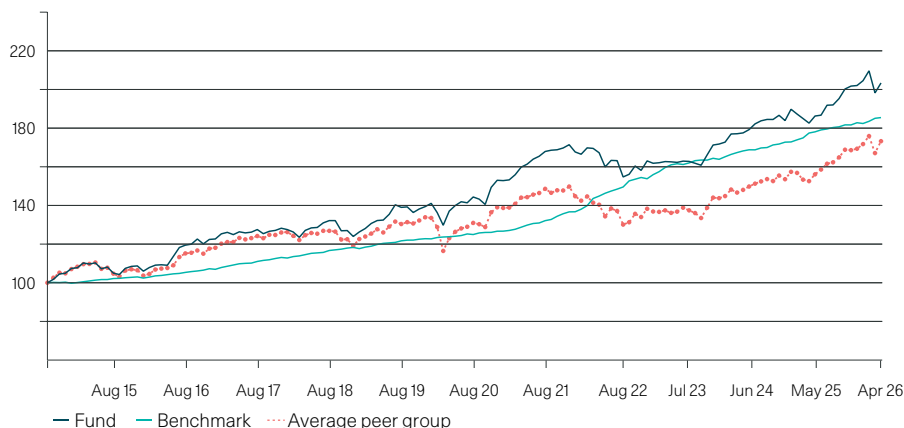
